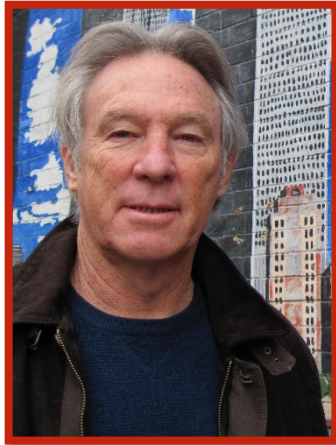

**Paul Dresman** was born in Los Angeles in 1943. Poet, translator of poetry in Spanish, essayist, editor of literary journals, including bilingual *helicóptero*, he taught 20th century literature at the University of Oregon. Recent work in *34th Parallel* (Paris); *Be Untaxed* (Burma); *The Shanghai Literary Review* (China); *Critical Read* (New York); and the American anthology of climate change, *The End of the World Project*.

**Jesús Sepúlveda** is a Chilean poet who teaches at the University of Oregon. He is the author of eight poetry collections and three essays, including his green-anarchist manifesto *The Garden of Peculiarities* (2002), his book on Latin American poetry *Poets on the Edge* (2016), and his collected poems *Poemas de un bárbaro* (2013). His third collection *Hotel Marconi* (1998) was translated into English by Paul Dresman and made into a film in Chile in 2009.
